- In what turned out to be the series finale on Saturday night, Dunedin racked up 13 runs in the first five innings to defeat Daytona 13-7 at Jackie Robinson Ballpark. Sunday's scheduled series finale was canceled due to Tropical Storm Debbie.

- Braden Barry had his best game of the season, going 3-4 with 3 RBIs and a two-run homer - his first in Single-A.

- Arjun Nimmala blasted his third homer of the week and also collected three RBIs.

- The contest featured four lead changes in the first three innings before Dunedin scored five runs in the top of the fourth to take the lead for good.

- Julio Ortiz capped a strong bullpen effort with a three-inning save, striking out six.

- The Blue Jays clinched a series victory with the win; four games to two.

ARJ LEADING THE CHARGE

Toronto's No. 4 prospect Arjun Nimmala had a strong week at the plate in Daytona. In six games, Nimmala went 8-24 with three homers and 9 RBIs. Nimmala's eight hits were tied for second in the FSL with Daytona's Trey Faltine, who won league player of the week honors. Overall, Nimmala has hit five homers across his last nine games.

BIG TIME BULLPEN

Dunedin's bullpen effectively shouldered a heavy load throughout last week's six game in five day stretch. In 27.2 innings, Blue Jays relievers surrendered just six earned runs (an ERA of 1.95).

A WEEK OF FIRSTS

Last week's series in Daytona was a week of firsts for members of the Blue Jays roster:

- Brock Tibbitts, Aaron Parker and Carter Cunningham all have collected their first professional hits.

- Arjun Nimmala collected three hits on Thursday - the first three hit game of his career.

- Aaron Parker become the first member of the 2024 Toronto Draft Class to hit a homer with Friday's solo shot.

- Braden Barry collected his first Single-A homer on Saturday.

DURAN DURAN

Dunedin backstop Edward Duran has gone 8-17 across his last five games, extending his excellent second half stretch. In 21 second half contests, Duran is hitting .296 - the highest among Blue Jays with at least nine games played, while his .801 OPS is second to Arjun Nimmala.

IN THE HUNT

After Sunday's rainouts, Dunedin stands 3 games out of first place in the FSL-West second half standings. While the deficit is small, the Blue Jays also trail second place Lakeland (1 GB of FTM) and third place Tampa (2GB).

WELCOME, CLASS OF 2024

After Brock Tibbitts, Carter Cunningham and Aaron Parker joined the roster last week, Dunedin has added the following players from the 2024 Draft/UDFA class: RHP Colby Holcombe, RHP Colby Martin, RHP Jay Schueler, INF Sean Keys, OF JR Freethy, OF Nick Mitchell, and OF Eddie Micheletti. All seven additions played college baseball this spring.

GETTING RATIOED

A number of Blue Jays 2024 draft picks boasted an impressive walk to strikeout ratio at the plate during the spring college baseball season (see right). Of Toronto's 21 draft selections, 16 were selected out of college.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

The Blue Jays have played 35 one-run games this season - tied for the most in the FSL. The Jays are 18-17 in those contests. 68 of the Blue Jays 100 games this season (68%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 37-31 record in those games. Five of the six games this season between the Jays and Cardinals have been decided by three or fewer tallies.

REHAB CITY, USA

With RHP Andrew Bash added to the roster Saturday Dunedin has hosted a whopping 21 MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. Other notable rehabs include top prospect Ricky Tiedemann, Joey Votto, Alek Manoah, Damiano Palmegiani, and Riley Tirota.

- Drafted by the Blue Jays in the 19th round of the 2022 draft out of Westfield High school in the Indianapolis area... Signed out of Cincinnati commitment.
- Was the fifth player to be drafted out of Westfield HS - recent draftees include big leaguers Ryan Pepiot (TB) and Kevin Plawecki (BOS).
- Low-to-mid 90s fastball is considered best pitch, complimented by a slider and split changeup.
- Pitched to an 0.74 ERA in 38 innings during his senior year of high school, striking out 83.
